Use Goodshop!

With the holidays coming up, many of us are going to make online purchases for gifts or other reasons. When you're doing that, one small way that you can help support TFDA would be to use the GoodShop portal to access many online retailers. It's pretty easy to do this, it just requires going to the GoodShop.com site to tell them that you want to support TFDA, finding your retailer in their list (they have hundreds including most of the popular online sites), and then clicking through to the site from the link on the GoodShop page. Once you've set up the charity once, in the future you should be able to skip that step when you go back to the site.

Any purchases you make at that point will automatically include a small percentage donation to TFDA. The price you pay should be the same regardless of whether you use GoodShop or not, but TFDA will benefit a small amount if you do. The exact percentages vary from retailer to retailer.
